This painting was made in the **South of France**.

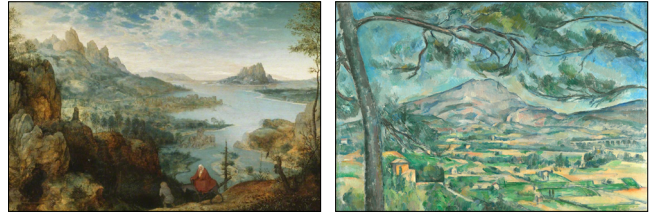
In the foreground there is a large **pine tree**.
