REGISTRATION

- An official form of identification is required for your first visit.

CLOAKROOM

- Jackets, bags, and backpacks will need to be left in the cloakroom provided. Food and drink (including water) may not be brought into the Study Room.

LIST OF WORKS

- Prior to your visit, please send us a list of the works you would like to view, with their inventory numbers. The collection can be searched in our [Collection Online](#).

INSTRUCTIONS FOR HANDLING ORIGINAL WORKS

- Writing is permitted **with pencil only**. Use of a portable computer is allowed.
- The original works may not be touched.
- Please turn away from the original work if you need to cough or sneeze.
- Study room staff will provide you with further, more detailed instructions for how to handle the original works on site.
- Photography (without a tripod and without flash) is allowed for personal use only.

WHEELCHAIR USERS

- The Prints and Drawings Study Room is not wheelchair accessible. Alternative arrangements can be made in advance upon request.
