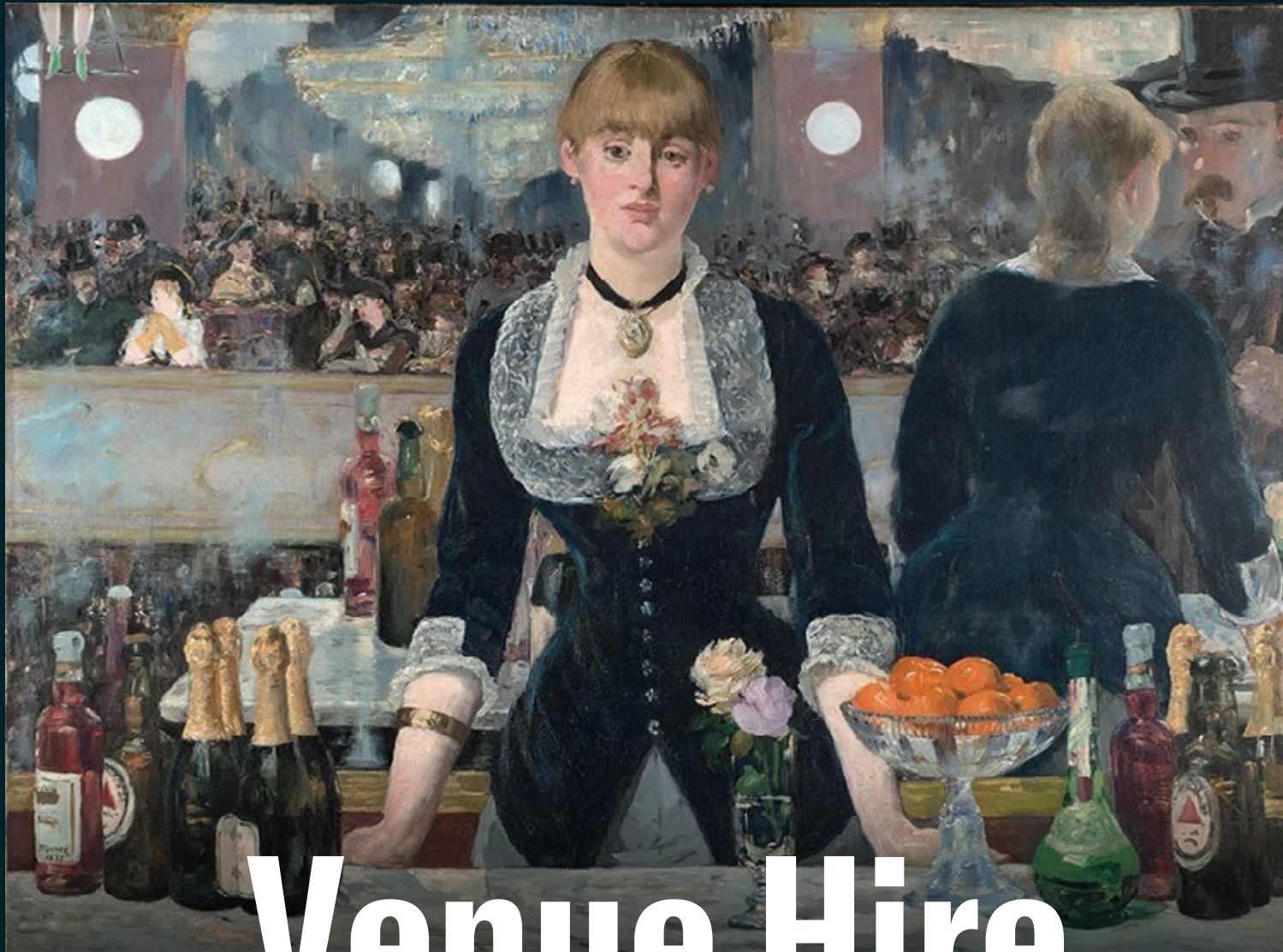

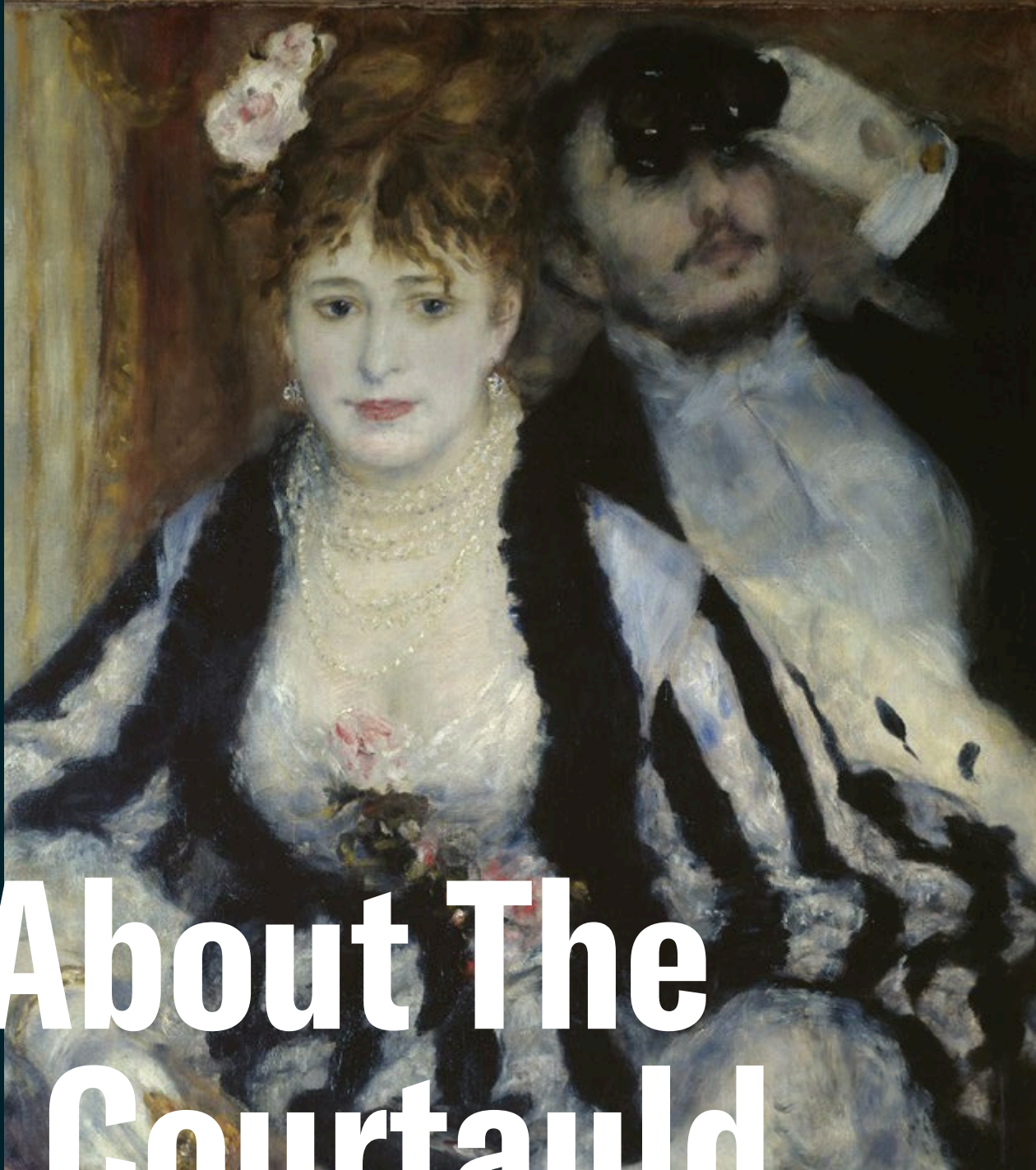

About The Courtauld

The Courtauld Institute of Art is a world-leading institution in the study and research of art history.

It is home to one of the greatest art collections in the UK, located in the magnificent historical setting of Somerset House. The collection is renowned for its remarkable Impressionist and Post-Impressionist paintings, including iconic works by Manet, Degas, Monet, van Gogh, Gauguin, and Cézanne.

Boasting extraordinary newly renovated rooms and spaces, The Courtauld offers exceptional opportunities for entertaining in one of the most prestigious buildings in central London. Immerse your guests in an inspirational setting surrounded by art curated with the utmost academic rigour.

Blavatnik Fine Rooms

The elegantly restored Blavatnik Fine Rooms showcase some of the greatest and most-loved works from The Courtauld's Collection from the Renaissance through to the 18th Century. A major highlight is Botticelli's large-scale *The Trinity With Saints*. Also featuring a room dedicated to works by Peter Paul Rubens, and a comprehensive collection of decorative arts including ornate ceramics.

Three of the most prominent artistic, scientific and historical societies had their meeting rooms in these spaces – the Royal Academy, Royal Society and Society of Antiquaries. The architect of Somerset House, William Chambers, was a founding member of the Royal Academy and made sure its rooms on this floor were sumptuously decorated with stunning ceilings, beautiful fireplaces and ornate door handles.

A suite of six galleries spanning the entire second floor of the building makes it possible to host a standing reception for up to 250 guests, or an intimate seated dinner for up to 60 in the Rubens and Baroque Room.

LVMH Great Room

The spectacularly restored LVMH Great Room is the home of masterpieces from The Courtauld's world-renowned Collection of Impressionist and Post-Impressionist paintings. Highlights include Manet's *A Bar at the Folies-Bergère* (1882), *Van Gogh's Self-Portrait with Bandaged Ear* (1889), and the most significant collection of works by Cézanne in the UK.

The LVMH Great Room is London's oldest purpose-built exhibition space and was the former home of the Royal Academy's Summer Exhibition. Previously subdivided, the newly renamed LVMH Great Room has been reinstated to its original breath-taking proportions and provides an unforgettable new space for events.

The LVMH Great Room is directly adjacent to our special exhibition space, the Denise Coates Exhibition Galleries, providing the perfect setting for a reception with private view of a major exhibition.

The Griffin Catalyst Exhibition: Seurat and the Sea 13 Feb - 17 May 2026

In 2026, The Courtauld will present the first ever exhibition dedicated to the seascapes of the French artist Georges Seurat (1859–1891).

This major, focused display will be the first devoted to Seurat in the UK in almost 30 years. It will chart the evolution of his radical and distinctive style through the recurring motif of the sea.



Hepworth in Colour 12 June – 6 Sep 2026

Barbara Hepworth is best known for her abstract sculptural forms inspired by nature and the rugged seaside landscapes of Cornwall, where she lived and worked.

This ambitious exhibition will be the first to explore a less familiar aspect of her work, the artist's lifelong fascination with colour, which she used in highly original and unexpected ways.



Salman Toor: Someone Like You 2 Oct 2026 - 10 Jan 2027

The Courtauld Gallery will present the first solo exhibition in Europe of the acclaimed New York-based painter Salman Toor (b.1983).

The exhibition focuses on Toor's exploration of human interactions and the desire and struggle to belong, culturally and emotionally. It will bring together around 20 of the artist's most iconic, thought-provoking and yet humorous paintings that represent people in shared moments of friendship and love, as well as experiencing solitude and alienation.

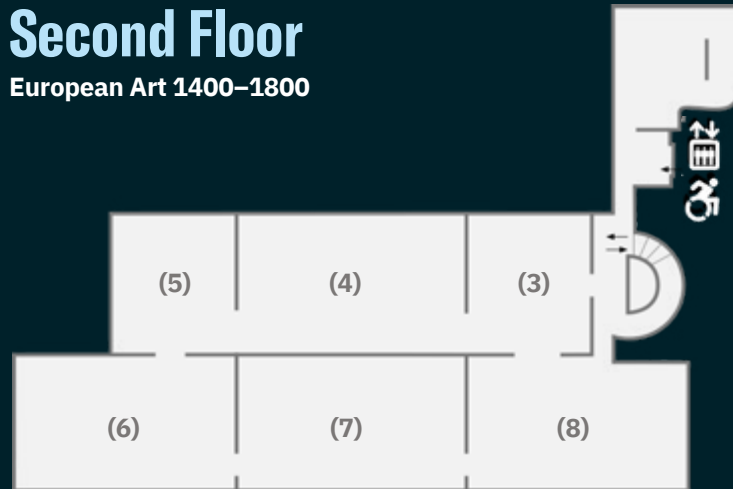

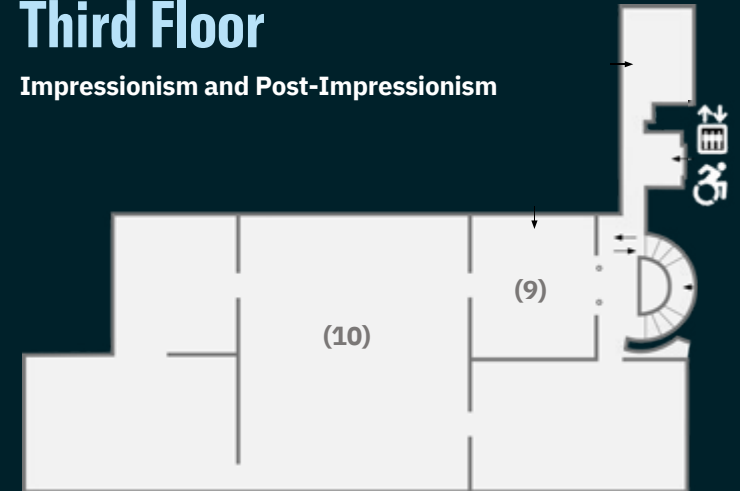

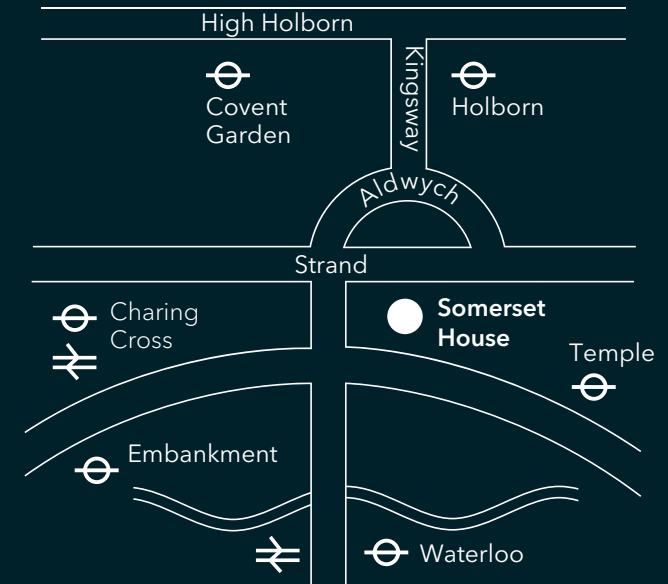
