The Courtauld Collection

Our remarkable collection comprises over 33,000 objects ranging from the Middle Ages to the 21st century and includes paintings, drawings, ceramics and sculptures. We share these works with the public at the Courtauld Gallery in Somerset House.

The Gallery is most famous for its exceptional group of Impressionist and Post-Impressionist paintings, with iconic works by Vincent van Gogh, Édouard Manet, Claude Monet and Edgar Degas, and the largest permanent collections of work by both Paul Cézanne and Georges Seurat in the UK.

Alongside this sits a world-class collection of works by Peter Paul Rubens, and Renaissance masterpieces by Sandro Botticelli, Lucas Cranach and Pieter Bruegel.

Close to a quarter of a million people visit the Gallery each year, with over 90% of those visitors giving consistently positive ratings.



Exhibitions at the Courtauld

Our exhibition programme is visually compelling, rooted in academic excellence, and designed to spark fresh perspectives on remarkable works of art.

Since reopening in 2021, the Courtauld has delivered a series of celebrated exhibitions, including widely acclaimed 5-star shows on Vincent van Gogh, Edvard Munch, Peter Doig, Claudette Johnson and Claude Monet.
