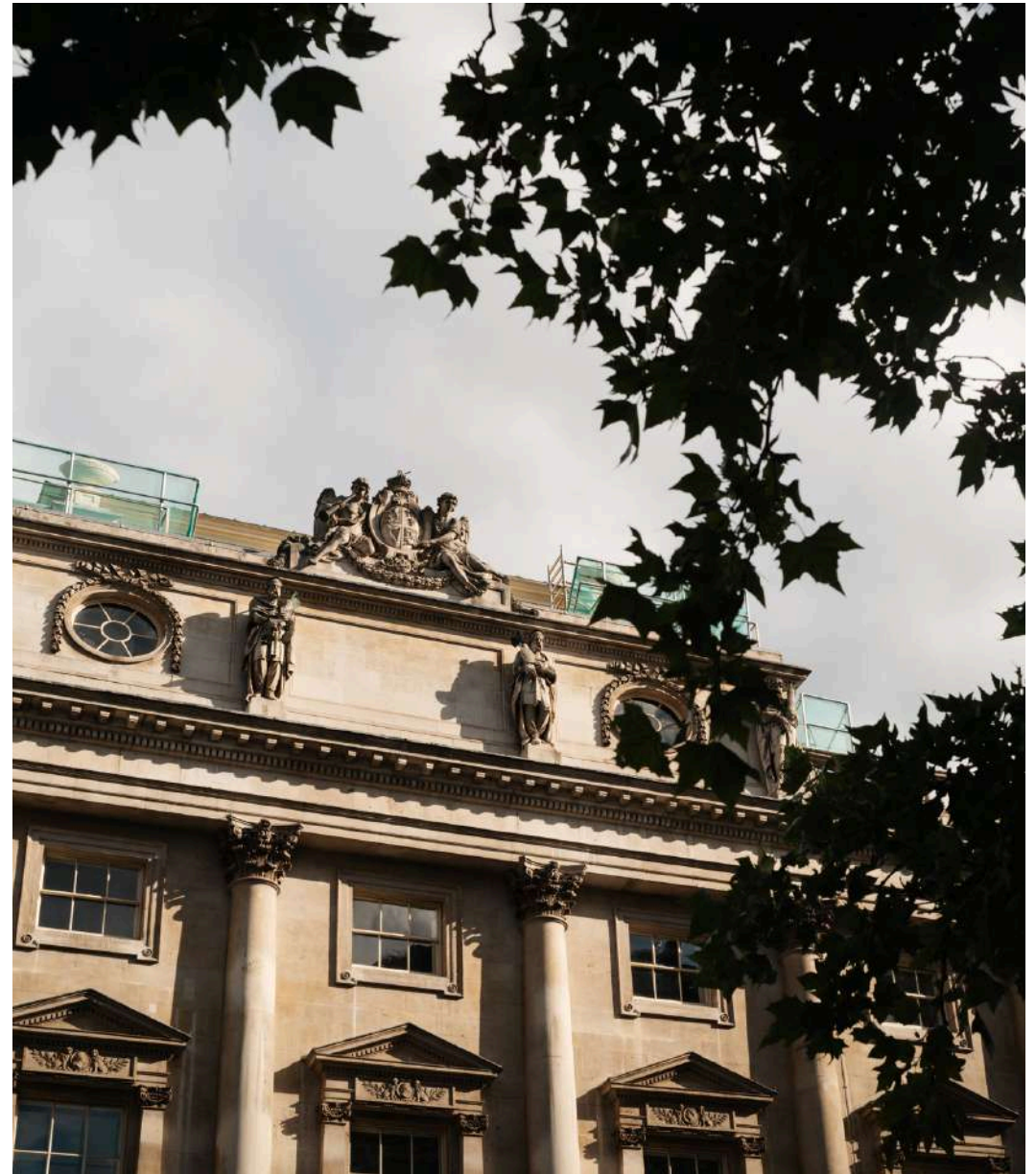
About the Courtauld

Our Gallery is home to one of the greatest art collections in the world, located in the magnificent historical setting of Somerset House. Spread across three floors, our remarkable collection includes paintings, drawings, prints, sculpture and decorative arts, ranging from the medieval period to the present day.

Academically, the Courtauld is a specialist university and home to the largest community of art historians and conservators in the UK.

Boasting extraordinary rooms and spaces, the Courtauld offers exceptional opportunities for entertaining in one of the most prestigious buildings in central London. Immerse your guests in an inspirational setting surrounded by art curated with the utmost academic rigour.

Second Floor

Blavatnik Fine Rooms

The elegantly restored Blavatnik Fine Rooms are a suite of six galleries that span the second floor, displaying highlights from The Courtauld's collection from the Renaissance to the 18th century. Highlights include Botticelli's *The Trinity with Saints*, a dedicated Rubens room, and decorative arts such as ceramics and Islamic metalwork.

The historic, richly decorated interiors were designed by William Chambers for institutions including the Royal Academy, when formerly based at Somerset House and the rooms on this floor have been sumptuously decorated with stunning ceilings, beautiful fireplaces and ornate door handles.

Our Second Floor can host a standing reception for up to 250 guests. Our Rubens and Baroque Room, the Gallery's premier dining space, can accommodate an intimate seated dinner for up to 60.

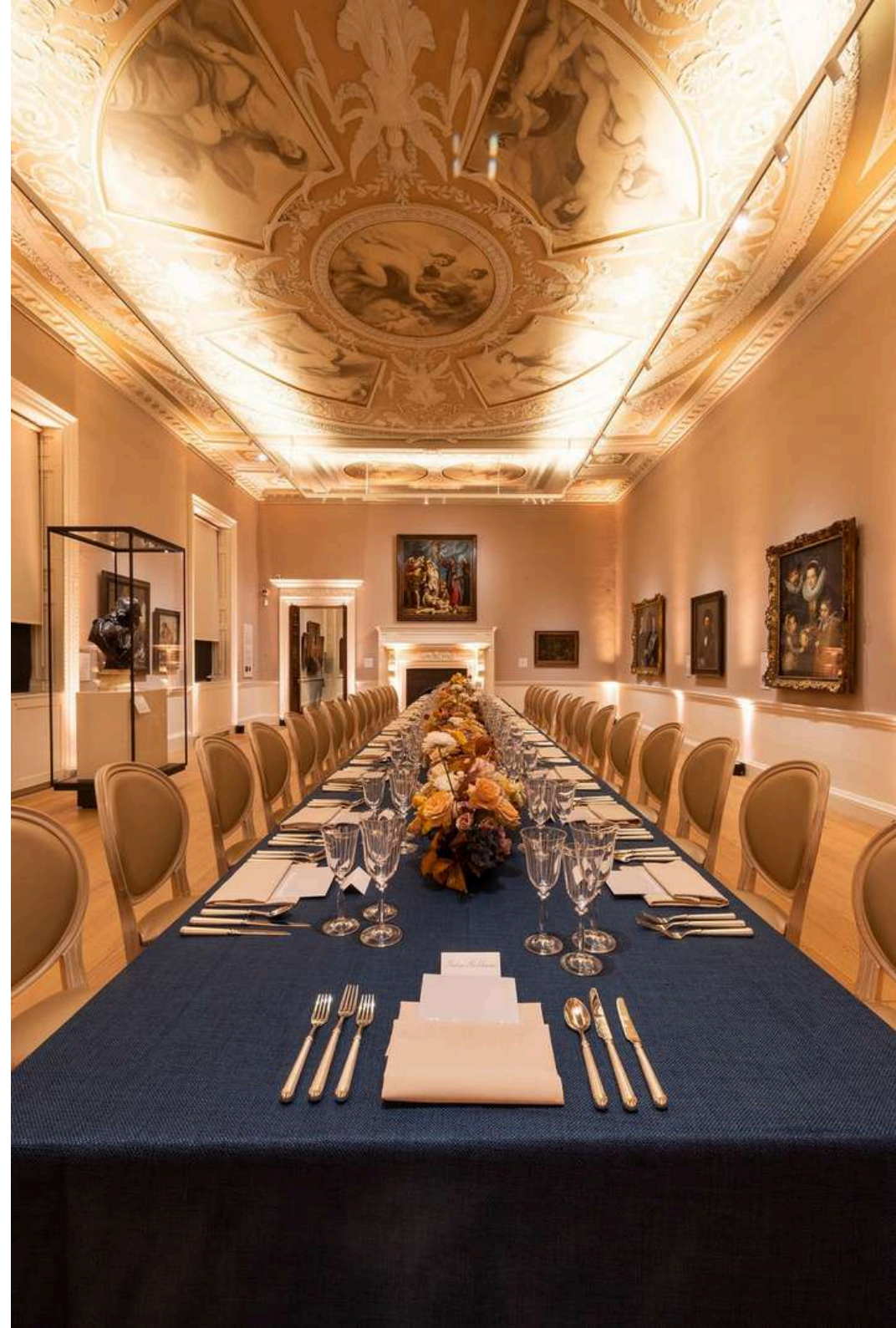

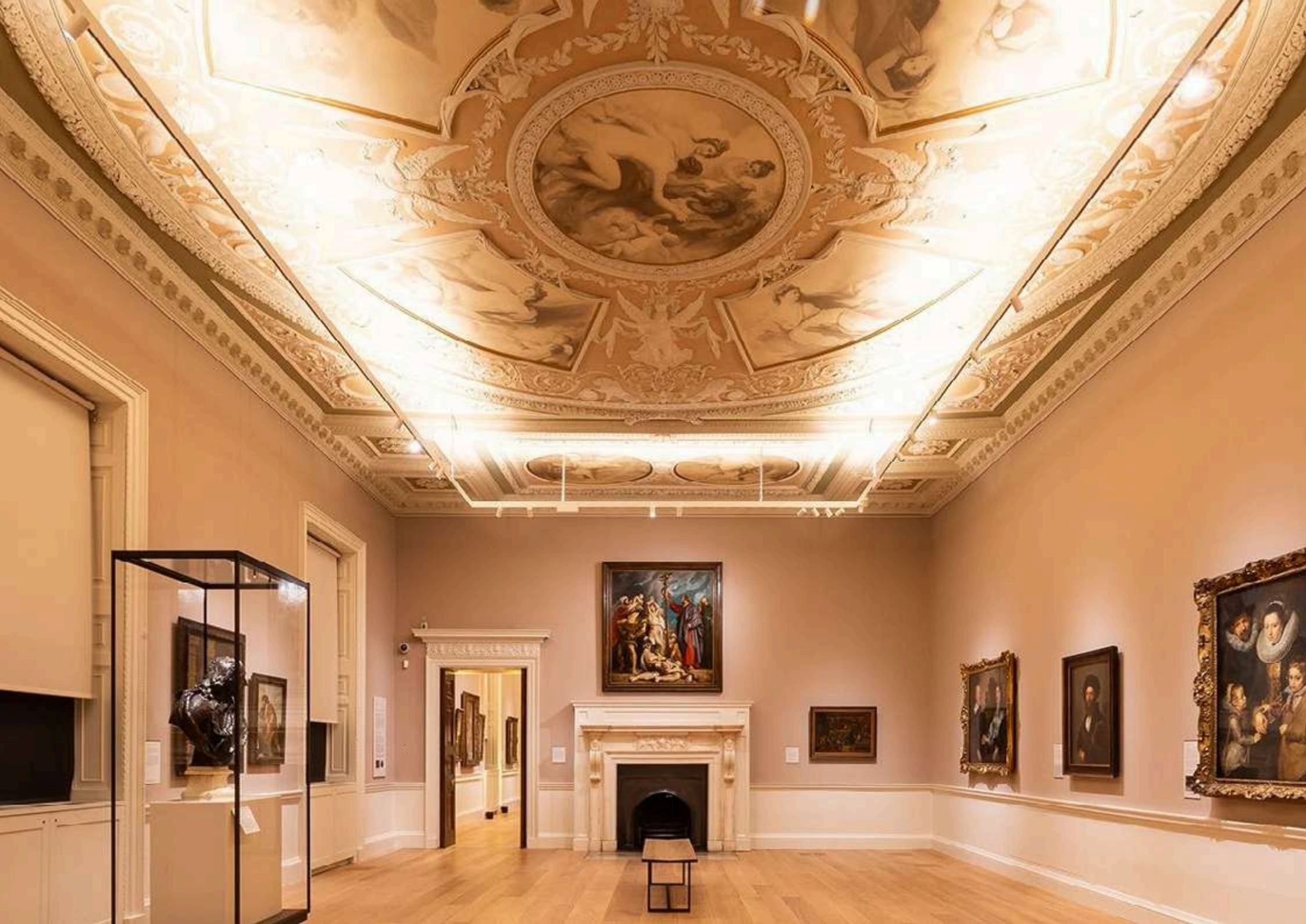

Third Floor

LVMH Great Room | Weston Gallery

Greeting guests as they enter the Third Floor Galleries, the Weston Gallery is a welcoming ante-room featuring works by Degas, Manet and Pissarro and is ideally suited to greet guests with welcome refreshments.

The spectacularly restored LVMH Great Room is the home of masterpieces from The Courtauld's world-renowned collection of Impressionist and Post-Impressionist paintings. Highlights include Manet's *A Bar at the Folies-Bergère* (1882), Van Gogh's *Self-Portrait with Bandaged Ear* (1889), and the most significant collection of works by both Cézanne and Seurat in the UK. London's oldest purpose-built exhibition space and former home of the Royal Academy's Summer Exhibition, the LVMH Great Room provides an unforgettable new space for events.

Our special exhibition space, the Denise Coates Exhibition Galleries, is directly adjacent, providing the perfect setting for a reception with private view of a major exhibition.
